## Features:

If you have the correct aspect the Hornbeam is one of the most spectacular ornamental upright deciduous trees. Hornbeam have very clean lines and perfect shape. The leaf colour and shape is amazing for modern formal settings as well as traditional gardens.

## Suggested Uses:

Very formal, clean, modern gardens

## Requirements:

Some summer sun protection recommended. Well composted soils, irrigation.  
Medium to slow growing.

## Care:

Good regular watering in Summer.  
Best planted in late winter from established potted stock.



<b>Species</b>	Carpinus betulus 'Fastigiata'
<b>Aspect</b>	Needs to be planted where it won't get the hot summer afternoon sun. Can take a semi-shaded spot.
<b>Spacing</b>	1.8m to 2.5m apart so as to show individual shape of tree
<b>Height</b>	5 – 8m in the first 10+ years
<b>Width</b>	1.2 to 1.5m if not clipped, will widen out after 10+ years
<b>Clipped Height</b>	4 - 5m is ideal
<b>Clipped Width:</b>	1.2m
