

# Magnolia 'Little Gem'

Bay Road Nursery Screening Collection



## Features:

Magnolia Little Gem is one of the best evergreen, medium size screening plants. Over the years, it has proven itself to be a fashionable screening plant.

Retaining a bushy shape, the Little Gem always looks good and doesn't grow too big. It has large white perfumed flowers, all year round, and tolerates most conditions. One feature is the brown colour on the back of the leaf, for those who don't like this you could consider the larger leafed St Mary Magnolia.

We find them quite tolerant to possums and they can be planted all year round.

## Care:

Care is essential to maintain a thick bushy screen. Little Gems thrive in a well composted soil. They like a regular water in summer and an annual tip prune in spring to encourage a bushy habit. You may have seen Little Gems that aren't thick this is because they haven't received the attention they need.
